Made pursuant to Section 3351 & 3352, Revenue and Taxation Code

I, Cass Cook, Tulare County Auditor-Controller/ Treasurer-Tax Collector, State of California, certify as follows: That at 12:01 a.m. on July 2, 2024, by operation of law, any real property (unless previously tax-defaulted and not redeemed) that has any delinquent taxes, assessments or other charges levied for the fiscal year 2023/2024, and/or any delinguent supplemental taxes levied for any year prior to 2023/2024 shall be declared tax-defaulted.
