RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EXETER SUCCESSOR AGENCY OVERSIGHT BOARD APPROVING THE LONG RANGE PROPERTY MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 34173(d), the City of Exeter ("Successor Agency") elected to become the successor agency to the former Redevelopment Agency of the City of Exeter ("Agency"); and

WHEREAS, the City of Exeter Successor Agency Oversight Board, established pursuant to Section 34179 of Assembly Bill 1484, is charged with administering all necessary affairs resulting from the dissolution of the Exeter Redevelopment Agency; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 34191.5, the Successor Agency is required to prepare a Long Range Property Management Plan to address the disposition and use of any real property of the former Exeter Redevelopment Agency; and

WHEREAS, at the time of dissolution, the Exeter Redevelopment Agency owned no real property, and therefore there are no properties to be managed; and

WHEREAS, the City of Exeter Successor Agency Oversight Board considered the matter at a publicly noticed meeting on this date (Monday September 29, 2014) at City Hall in the city of Exeter,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City of Exeter Successor Agency Oversight Board, as follows:

The City of Exeter Successor Agency Oversight Board hereby determines that there are no real properties owned by the former Exeter Redevelopment Agency, and directs staff to submit to the appropriate agencies of the State of California a Long Range Property Management Plan indicating that the Agency did not own any such properties at the time of dissolution and thus the Successor Agency has no further obligations or actions to take in this regard.
